FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- How are the campers disciplined?
First time – warning. Second times – miss activity. Third time – sent to Camp Director. Continued disobedience may result in dismissal from camp.

- May I call my teenager at camp?
Campers can receive calls only in the case of an emergency. Incoming calls are discouraged out consideration for other campers and planned activities. Most evenings campers will be afforded an opportunity to call home if desired.

- Can I reach someone at camp any time of the day or night in case of an emergency?
Yes – The emergency number is (903) 691-3633. EMERGENCY ONLY.

- What do you do for homesick teens? Do you let them call home?
Campers are allowed to call home at the Camp Director's discretion. Campers who become homesick and leave their camp session early are not eligible for refunds.

- Can parents send special food to replace sweets?
Special foods can be sent only if medically necessary. Snacks are not allowed in the bunkhouses and would therefore need to be turned in by the counselor to the Concession Stand.

- ❖ That I will work towards the goals of camp and the building of our group into a Christian Community by participating wholeheartedly and enthusiastically in all activities planned for my group.
- ❖ That I will respect the rights and property of others as well as respect and accept others for who they are and the beliefs they hold. I will act in a friendly, respectful manner towards other campers and staff.
- ❖ That I will speak up and let my counselors know when I have a problem, need or concern. I will listen to my counselors, show respect for them and follow their instructions during my time at Ferncliff.
- ❖ That I will use appropriate language while at camp, and not cuss or use words or say things that would prompt my grandmother to wash my mouth out with soap.
- ❖ That I will remain onsite at Ferncliff for the duration of the camp session except in cases of emergency or as determined by the Program Director.
- ❖ That I will remain in my cabin and on my bunk during FOB, other rest times and after lights out.
- ❖ That electronic items are not needed while at camp and that I will not bring an mp3 player, CD player, radio, iPod, computer, TV, DVD player, videogame or other electronic device to camp.
- ❖ That I will not bring food, snacks or candy with me or have it mailed to me at camp because it encourages insects and other critters to be in cabins and other places where they don't belong.
- ❖ That I understand that it would be disruptive and distracting for any camper to make or receive phone calls during camp out side scheuled times. I will leave my cell phone with the Director. I understand that visitors are welcome at camp only during Check In and at the end of camp when my parents or guardians pick me up.
- ❖ That I will not to bring or use any alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs, fireworks, lewd materials, or other substances harmful to me while at camp. I will not bring firearms, knives or other weapons to camp. I will not engage in violent behavior, stealing, pulling pranks, public nudity or cohabitation while at camp.
- ❖ That I will encourage others to understand and abide by this covenant and strive to be a supportive member of my group and the camp community.

I understand that success in abiding by this covenant will result in a positive personal and group experience, and a fun time at camp! I also understand that failure to abide by these guidelines may result in me being sent home at my parent's/guardian's expense. I understand that this agreement is not only a contract between me, my parents/guardians, Camp Miles, my counselors and other camp leaders, but also a covenant before the Lord.
